ASSOCIATION OF KOSOVO MUNICIPALITIES

• The Association of Kosovo Municipalities (AKM) has been established in **2001** after the first democratic municipal elections after the war in Kosovo.

Establishment of the Association of Kosovo Municipalities relies on Section 10 of European Charter for Local Self Government of Council of Europe (the right to association).

• The AKM is a non-profitable organization with legal status representing the general interests of its members.

Members of Association are local authorities in Kosovo.



PROFESSIONAL COLLEGIUMS

• AKM Collegiums (20) are one of the basic mechanisms of AKM and include all municipalities, represented by directors of municipal departments or officials of respective sector in municipalities.

COLLEGIUM OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE

- The Collegium of Health and Social Welfare is a mechanism, which includes all Health and Social Welfare Directors of the Municipalities of the Republic of Kosovo.
- Key activities of AKM's HEALTH Collegium are:
 - Lobbing and Advocacy on:
 - (Laws, Secondary Legislation, Government regarding Primary Health Care)
 - Peer Exchange between municipalities on issues covering Primary Health Care, and disseminating good practice;



COLLEGIUM OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE

- Professional assistance to Municipal Assembly, Mayor, and supports decision-making process;
- Working Groups represents Association of Kosovo Municipalities in drafting legislation, secondary legislation regarding primary health care;
 Cooperation with local and international partners,

Collegium of Health and Social Welfare:

- Has its regular meetings, which include minimum six meetings per year.
- Has its Strategic Plan 2023-2025 and its yearly action plans





KOSOVO HEALTH SYSTEM

- > The health system in Kosovo is organized in three levels: primary, secondary and tertiary level.
- The primary healthcare level falls within the competencies of <u>the local authorities-municipalities</u>, whereas the secondary and tertiary are competencies of the national level.
- > Exemption from this is the capital city, who has the right to form its secondary institutions as well.
- Kosovo has 38 municipalities, and within their primary health care system they each have: a main family medicine center, family medicine centers, as well as ambulatory centers. The number of the last two depend on the number of citizens each municipality has.
- According to the 2021 statistics there were: 3 168 800 visits to Family Medicine Centers, 226 822 were dental visits; 1 301 151 were laboratory services; and 5 351 537 were special interventions and services.*

KOSOVO HEALTH SYSTEM



- Secondary <u>health care</u> refers to a higher level of health care system, in which patients from <u>primary</u> <u>health care</u> are referred for more specialized treatments. It comprises of seven regional hospitals.
- The tertiary level is the highest specialized medical level. <u>Kosovo</u>'s tertiary health care specialized medical services are offered by medical institutions such as University Clinical Center of Kosovo, University Dentistry Clinical Center of Kosovo, National Blood Transfusion Center, National Institute of Labor Medicine, Medical Center for Sport and Recreation, National Institute of Public Health and Faculty of Medicine
