# General approach to AMR containment in Sweden

- Sweden has one of the lowest AMR levels in the world
- One Health approach
  - Environmental
  - Animal
  - Human
- “Strama” – strategic programme against antibiotic resistance
  - Network started in 1995
  - Voluntary basis
  - Local subgroups emerged quickly – work directly with the healthcare practitioners
  - Since 2006 permanent funding

# Strama in Östergötland

- Why focusing on the primary care sector?
- Staff members working part-time with Strama
  - Supporting the primary care sector practitioners
  - Offer all primary care centers a yearly dialogue
  - Also cooperating with different levels
  - Each primary care center are recommended to have a Strama responsible physician
- Main tool is the “Strama-dashboard”
  - Implemented in 2019
  - Extracts data on the use of antibiotics – creates a report
  - Mainly use the report for dialogue, but also rates assessment
  - Every Strama-responsible physician has the possibility to extract data on an individual level



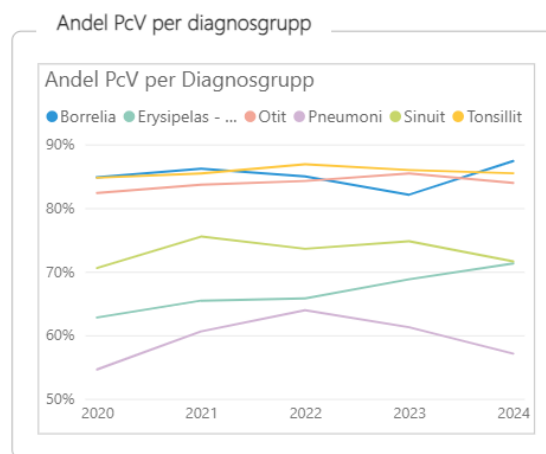
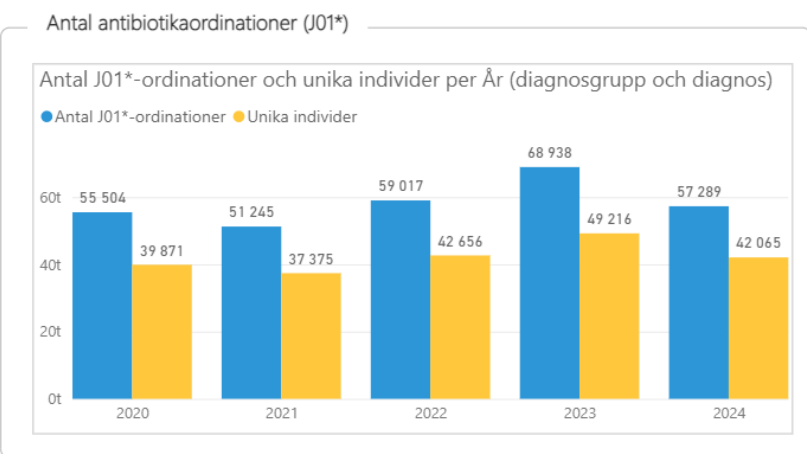
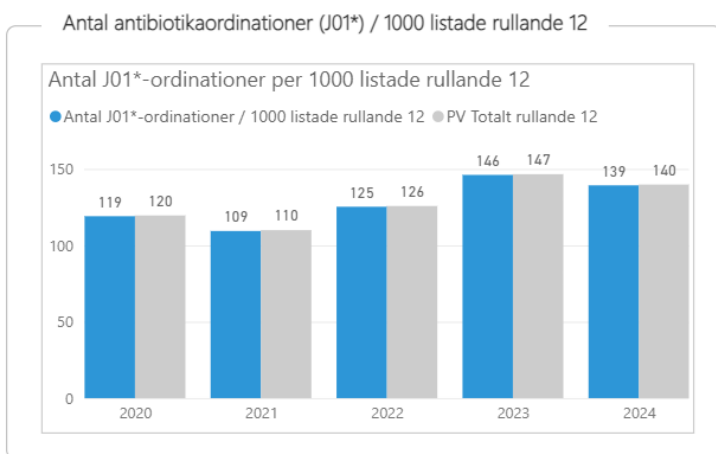
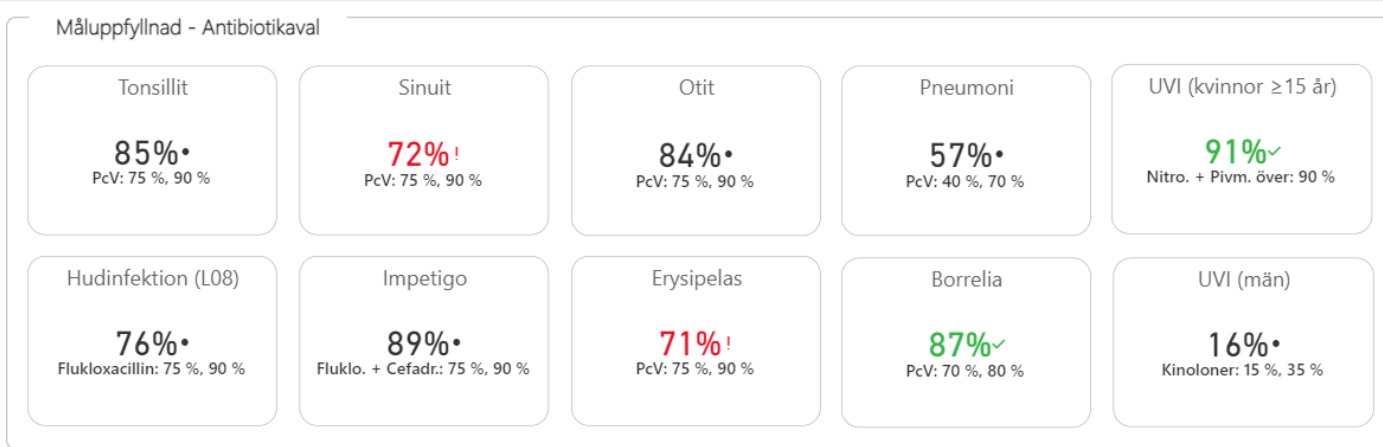
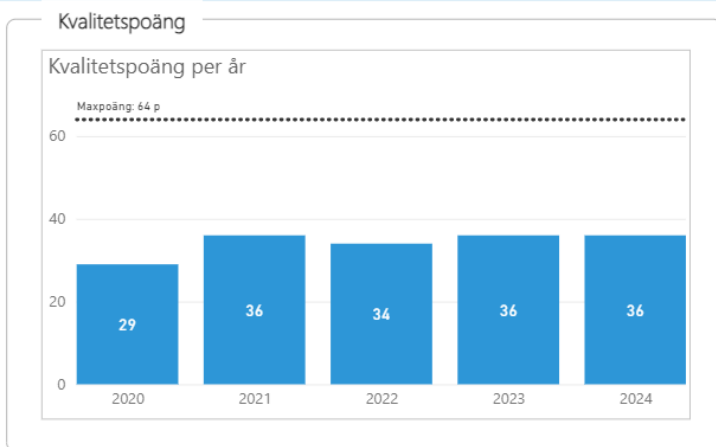


## What makes it successful

- Main purpose is not to look for problems
- The dialogues have been recurring for years
- Requested from management level
- The data plays into the authorization assessments of the care centres

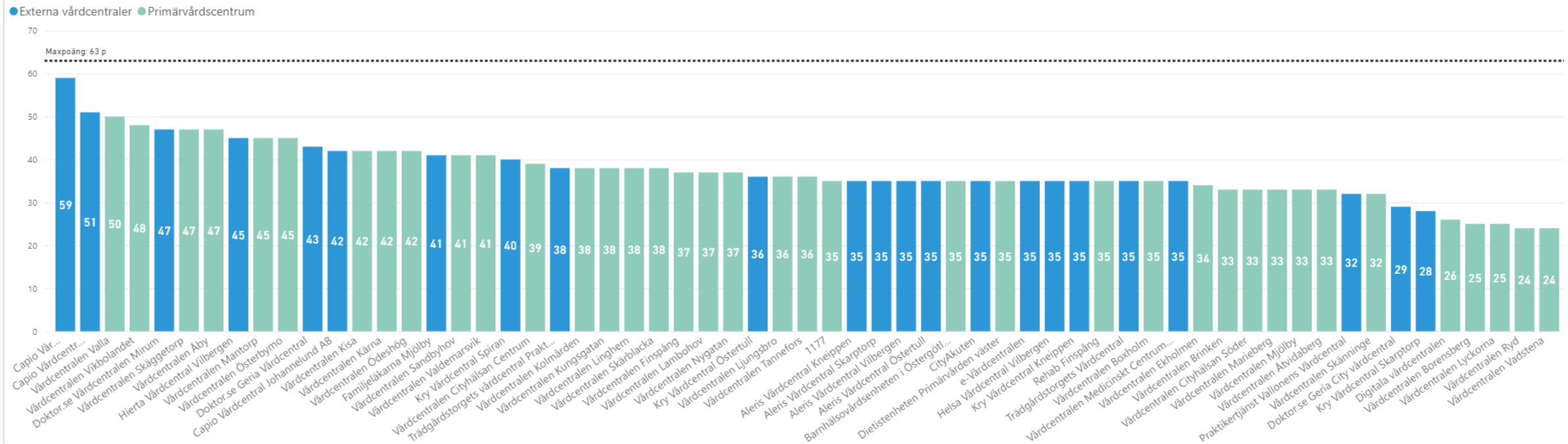
Strama Primärvård Översikt - Antibiotikaordinationer inom primärvården
